

Raama (Winged-Elf)

Relations between woodland creatures, although not common, do happen. Relations between pixies and elves are most common among those. Oft times these relationships result in offspring with traits of both parents.

A raama's life can be quite difficult, particularly if it lives among its fellow pixies. Due to the larger stature of their elf parent they tend to grow larger than their pixie counterparts, and soon physically outgrow the pixie environment. It is akin to an elf living in a Halfling community. Due to their elven nature they often find the constant mischievousness and trickery of pixies somewhat beneath their dignity.

Elven communities are much more comfortable for raamas. However, because they never grow larger than an elven child they are often treated as such. Many raamas end up in halfling communities though they find life there more mundane than they care for. Their pixie nature imbues a streak of adventure that is often fulfilled by wondering the human lands in search of glory.

Personality:

Raamas still possess mischievous nature of pixies, but are quite indignant when it's pointed out to them. Though playful at times also possess the elegance and sophistication of elves. Due to their long life they often try many different pursuits. Their beauty and grace draw many admirers, which tend to make them a bit vain. They spend a lot of time preening their wings and keeping their general appearance as neat as possible.

Physical description: Raamas are much larger than pixies, about the size of an elvish child, usually about 3 ½ feet and weighing about 30 pounds. They are much thinner and more delicate looking than elves but with longer pointier ears. They are free of facial or body hair. They prefer very light, colorful clothing and love jewelry of all sorts. Their main attraction is the large iridescent gossamer wings

on their back. The shape of the wings can vary from that resembling a dragonfly to a butterfly, but both are strikingly beautiful.

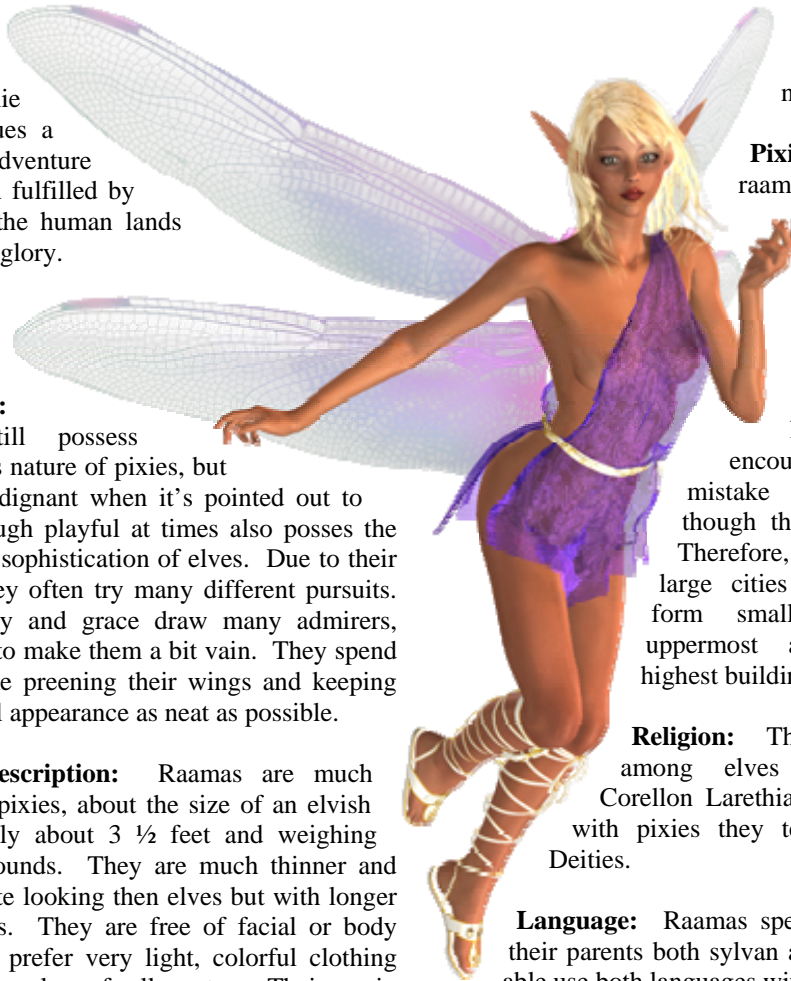
Relations: Raamas feel at home with pixies, elves, and halflings. They tend to find humans and dwarves brutish but tolerable. Gnomes have yet to prove themselves and half-orcs are regarded with contempt and distrust. They have a great appreciation and love for woodland creatures. While most creatures don't compare to the beauty of a raama it isn't held against them but jealousies often arise towards those that are more beautiful. Most creatures view raamas as a curiosity and they are always noticed. It is because of this they usually keep themselves invisible.

Alignment: The spirited, playful nature of raamas leads them strongly away from law. They believe in helping those less fortunate. They love beauty and nature, and despise evil and cruelty. Raamas are almost always good, but never evil.

Pixie-Elven Lands: A raama has no home land. They usually dwell in elven communities and are equally welcome in human and halfling settlements. Since most people have never encountered a pixie often mistake raamas as pixies, though they are much larger. Therefore, they usually avoid large cities although some do form small communities in uppermost apartments of the highest buildings.

Religion: Those who are raised among elves typically worship Corellon Larethian. If they grew up with pixies they tend toward the fey Deities.

Language: Raamas speak the languages of their parents both sylvan and elvish. They are able to use both languages with native ability.



Adventurers: The playful nature of raamas with their incapacity to assimilate to either pixie and elvish societies often leads them to adventure, both to prove themselves and seek glory they would otherwise never achieve.

Raama Racial Traits

- -4 Strength, -4 Constitution, +4 Dexterity, +4 Intelligence, +4 Charisma
- Max Strength: 12, Max Constitution: 14
- Small size, +1 to Armor Class, +1 bonus on attack rolls, +4 bonus on Hide checks, -4 penalty on grapple checks, lifting and carrying limits $\frac{3}{4}$ those of medium characters.
- Land speed is 20 feet. Fly speed is 60 feet.
- Medium load capacity reduces fly by half. A raama cannot fly with a heavy load.
- Low-light vision: A raama can see twice as far as a human in starlight, moonlight, torchlight and other poorly lit conditions.
- Skills: +2 racial bonus on Listen, Search and Spot checks. A raama who passes within 5 feet of a secret or concealed door is entitled to a Search check to notice it as if she were actively looking for it.
- Weapon Proficiencies: Martial weapon proficiency feats in short sword, dagger, short bow.
- If their class allows armor proficiency they can only use light armor.
- Any armor reduces movement to 15 feet, fly 50 feet.
- Automatic Languages: Common, Sylvan, Elven. Bonus Languages: Gnome, Halfling, Gnoll, Goblin, Orc, Draconic.
- Invisibility at will. Combat actions cause the character to become slightly visible, a sort of blurry transparency. If she is using range attacks from shadows treat as hide in shadows (DC10). Creatures with low light or dark vision are able to see a raama during combat.
- Spell-like abilities: a raama has a number of bonus spell like abilities based on their intelligence modifier that can be used once per day – lesser confusion, dancing lights, detect chaos, detect good, detect evil, detect law, detect thoughts, dispel magic, entangle, permanent image, polymorph (self). Caster level 8.
- Favored Class: Rogue. A multiclass raama's rogue class does not count when determining whether she takes an experience point penalty for multiclassing.
